The Franklin County Complex Coordinated Terrorist Attack (CCTA) is seeking volunteer role players for the upcoming Franklin County CCTA Capstone Full-Scale Exercise (FSE) on April 4th, 2020, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

You may volunteer at **one** of the locations that the exercise will be occurring at. All exercise play will take place between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

Volunteers are expected to play the role of a victim in an active threat scenario. Volunteers will interact with a variety of first responders during the exercise.

Due to the nature of this exercise, participants should be aware that:

- No one under the age of 18 may participate.
- At no point during the exercise will volunteers be allowed to take photos or videos.
- Volunteers will need to be at their exercise location no later than 8:15 a.m. and stay until the conclusion of the exercise at 4:00 p.m.
- All participants will be required to sign a waiver prior to starting the exercise.
